This week I reread an important statement about life written by the Apostle Paul: **“Don’t be misled: Bad company corrupts good character”** [1 Corinthians 15:33]. Another way of saying it is **“Don’t kid yourself that you’re any different from those you hang out with. We become a reflection of those around us.”** Basically, Paul means that if you spend time with those who are fearful or apathetic, you’ll probably learn to be afraid and indifferent. Surround yourself with vulgar, self-absorbed people and guess what you’ll be known for? Rub shoulders with people who complain about life; and you’ll discover that, in no time, you’ll be complaining, angry, and bitter!

But here’s the corollary: If bad company corrupts good character, then it may just be that the reverse is also true: **good company develops good character.** Courageous people who follow

through on big dreams bring out courage and hope in others. Generous people bring out joy and generosity in others, while faithful, caring people tend to surround themselves with compassionate, spirit-filled people.

It naturally follows then that Christians who want to become more like Christ surround themselves with people who reflect the image of Jesus in all that they say and do. They worship together; they work together for the common good; and they find new creative ways to share the Kingdom of God. The question is with which group are you most closely aligned?

Looking back over 2009, it is easy to see that God has been with us, guiding and helping us **“make disciples and make a difference”** in such activities as the community breakfast, Hearts and Hands, and Advent Conspiracy; and when I eagerly look ahead to 2010, I believe while I pray that

God will continue to change lives through our ministries. I invite you to join us in fulfilling the mission of First Church and, in the process, discover for yourself that by giving, serving, and sharing you have given the best gift ever — YOURSELF!

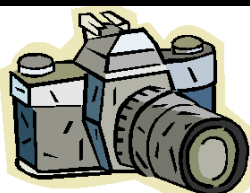

PRAYER: Spiritual Communion

Prayer is the heart of man in communion with the heart of the Father. It is the heart of the Father bestowing grace and mercy upon the heart of man. And it is the whole heart of man seeking to know the whole heart of God. Prayer is essentially the communion of two hearts. C. H. Spurgeon said, "True prayer is not a mere mental exercise, nor a vocal performance, but it is far deeper than that — it is spiritual communion with the Creator of heaven and earth. God is a Spirit unseen of mortal eye and only to be perceived by the inner man; our spirit within us, begotten by the Holy Ghost at our regeneration. Prayer is a spiritual business from beginning to end, and its aim and object end not with man, but reach to God Himself."

PRAYER POINTS

Praise God Who has invited you into His circle of fellowship through Jesus Christ. Thank Him for His invitation to love Him with your whole being (Mk. 12:33). Commit yourself to Deut. 10:12: "To fear the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, to love Him, and to serve [Him] with all your heart and with all your soul."

PRAYING THE HEART OF GOD

Know God. Know God's heart. Then: Pray God's heart into the creation. Creation is waiting for that reality to be so — for the people of the Spirit to retake the rightful oversight of the creation under God the True Spirit. This is the paradigm for prayer ministry — to know the will from the clear teaching of the Bible and by the experience of the Spirit, and then to pray it into existence. Praying Christians have known about this principle all their days of prayer. A burden to pray enters their heart. They know the person, and they are given some sense of how they are to pray. Then they pray until the intercession is accomplished. Today, ask God for Him "to initiate" in your praying. When you find yourself thinking of someone and offering a prayer, take this as God at work, reshaping your inner prayer life.

PRAYER POINTS

Praise God for the humility which Christ displayed in coming to earth and going to the cross for you (Phil. 2:8). Ask God to give you a servant's heart.

"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus" [Philippians 2: 3-4].

CORE VALUE LEAD WITH GRACE

Discipleship is not comfortable or convenient, but costly. We realize that many people live with deep spiritual wounds and broken dreams and are skeptical of the motives of others. As Christians, we are called to break through barriers that make us prisoners of our past and to be conduits of God's grace. We believe we are at our best when we set aside our wants and needs and share a smile or a kind word with others. Therefore, we will strive to be a blessing to everyone and to look for new, creative, and relevant ways to offer grace in a skeptical world. We will forgive when we have been wronged; we will believe the best of others when we don't understand; we will comfort because we have been comforted; and we will serve others before being served ourselves. By reaching out with gentleness, respect, and patience, we will inspire others to believe in the authenticity of our commitment to Christ. [Pastor Steve]

Ministry Moment

PRAYER

To John Wesley, prayer was more than a declaration of our needs and our praise. It is a return to God of the divine breath (or Spirit) that animates our life toward God. Through the Spirit, we receive the life of God. In the Spirit we are enabled to give this life back to God in the form of praise and prayer. Prayer thus completes the circuit of God's life: God's life comes into the world, effects our transformation, and returns as we faithfully respond to God. Prayer is the outstanding instance of our response, for in prayer we stand gratefully before God as those who have received and who now offer back to God the holy sacrifice of praise. Because prayer is the expression of our life toward God,...it includes the articulation of our deepest feelings as well as our desired for God's presence. [The Wesley Study Bible, NRSV]
